

Tyrannosaurus

(Tyrant Lizard King)

Also called “Tyrant Lizard King”, the Tyrannosaurus Rex was one of the most famous of the extinct reptiles.

Description: The T-Rex walked on two legs and had a huge head with large, pointed replaceable teeth. The T-Rex had tiny arms with two fingers each. It also had a slim and pointed tail that improved balance and helped it take quick turns while running.

Size: The Tyrannosaurus was 40 feet long and 15 to 20 feet tall. The Tyrannosaurus weighed approximately between 5 to 7 tons.

Period: The Tyrannosaurus lived during the late Cretaceous period, about 85-65 million years ago.

Habitat: United-States (Montana, Texas, Utah, Wyoming), Canada (Alberta, Saskatchewan) and East Asia (Mongolia)

Diet: The Tyrannosaurus was a carnivore (meat eater). The T-Rex cashed its prey and then ate it.
